

HOSPITALITY COMMITTEE

Purpose of the Committee:

To serve as host for Wesley and Felicia. The committee should coordinate all arrangements for their personal needs while in your community.

Work of the Committee:

Two months

Find housing. In most cases, Wesley and Felicia will be bringing a 38' motor home. Locate a parking spot with access to water, electrical and, if possible, sewer hook-ups. The church parking lot is fine.

On those occasions when the RV is not used, a motel is preferred, but not required. If you place Wesley in a home, be sure it has a private room with a place for study. The home of an older couple seems to work best, but again, that is not required. Please try to avoid places with tobacco smoke or house cats. (Allergies)

If they fly in, provide transportation both to and from the airport, and during the week.

Wesley & Felicia are available for noon meals with members of the congregation or groups. They do not eat dinner until after the evening service.

Confirm if lunch meetings are scheduled. If they are, plan meals for these meetings. Coordinate rooms needed for meals with the facilities chairperson.

One month

Confirm arrangements for housing, transportation, meals, and exercise.

Confirm arrangements for lunch meetings.

Contact Wesley's office to inform him of the address and phone number of the host, RV park, or hotel.

During the event

Be available to help if any need arises.

After event

Participate in the evaluation.

RV Parking Requirements

The RV is a 38' motor home with a height clearance of 12 1/2'. The width is approximately 14' when the slide-outs are extended.


It is fine to park the RV in the church parking lot if there is a level area large enough to hold it, close to a water and electrical connection. Sewer hookup is not required, but the location of the closest dump site would be helpful.

The **minimum** electrical connection required is 30 amps, but 50 amps is **preferable**. Ask an electrician to wire for a parallel 110 connection. The plug looks like a 220, but it is NOT.
